

**SUFFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (PARISHES OF HADLEIGH, SEMER AND KERSEY)
(STONE STREET) (A1141) (UNION HILL) (A1141) (30 MPH AND 40 MPH SPEED LIMIT
AND REVOCATION) ORDER 2025**

On 23rd July 2025 Suffolk County Council made the above Order for the Parishes of Hadleigh, Semer and Kersey under Section 84(1) (a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The effect of this is to introduce:

A 30 mph speed limit on:

- Stone Street (A1141), Hadleigh: in both directions from its junction with the A1071 (known as the Hadleigh Bypass) in a generally north westerly direction for a total distance of 768m.

A 40 mph speed limit on:

- Stone Street (A1141), Hadleigh: in both directions from a point 768m northwest of its junction with the A1071 (known as the Hadleigh bypass), travelling in a north westerly, then northerly directions to its Parish Boundary with Kersey.
- Stone Street (A1141), Kersey: in both directions from its southern Parish boundary with Hadleigh Town Council, travelling in a northerly direction to its Northern Parish Boundary with Semer Parish Council.
- Stone Street (A1141), Semer: in both directions from the northern Parish boundary of Kersey, travelling in a northerly direction to its junction with Overgang Road (U8419)
- Union Hill (A1141), Semer: in both directions from its junction with Overgang Road (U8419), travelling in a north westerly direction to a point 35m southeast of its junction with Bildeston Road (B1115)

This Order shall revoke the provisions of the Suffolk County Council (A1141 Stone Street, Hadleigh) (40mph Speed Limit) Order dated 9 October 2007.
